High Impact Programs

Beacon offers three High Impact Programs to Beacon schools.

Your involvement in this event will directly support funding for the following High Impact Programs for Beacon Schools in Tasmania.

POLISH

A one day workshop that helps young people prepare for their careers through personal presentation and communication training, giving students the skills to conduct themselves appropriately when entering the world of work and throughout their employment.

Core to the program is a sit-down lunch that gives students an opportunity to network with potential employers and use their newly found communication and culinary skills acquired in the morning tutorials.

LUNCH WITH THE GIRLS

A one day program targeting young 15-16 year old females who are at risk of disengaging from school or are without a positive female role model.

The 20 girls engage with a group of successful professional women from a variety of backgrounds as mentors.

BBQ WITH THE BOYS

A one day program targeting 15-16 year males who are at risk of disengaging from school, or who are without a positive role model.

The 20 young men who participate interact extensively with male mentors through workshops and physical activities.
