



# Community Hearings

The Tasmanian Parliament has established an independent body - the Electricity Supply Industry Expert Panel - to conduct a Review of the current position and future development of Tasmania's electricity industry.

The Panel is holding Community Hearings to provide interested members of the community with an opportunity to raise and discuss issues of relevance to the Review. Panel members will be available at the Hearings to take questions about the Review and hear comments directly from attendees on the core issues that they believe should be covered in the Panel's forthcoming Issues Paper. The Panel will also share some facts and initial observations on the Tasmanian electricity industry based on its investigations to date.
