St Vincent de Paul Society (Tasmania) Inc would like to alert THA Member businesses in Southern Tasmania (the 0362 telephone district) to a new service , which we can provide free of cost. It seems possible that from time to time it could be difficult for a Member business to dispose of furniture, manchester , bedding, linen, decor items when renovating or expanding premises etc.

As you may know, we have an extensive network of shops throughout the Southern region, whose primary purpose is to provide quality used clothing and **essential furniture items free of cost to people in need**, and to sell the surplus above that requirement, at year round bargain prices to the general community, especially to people of limited means.

We currently have 18 Shops in the region, from Swansea to Huonville, and New Norfolk and Ellendale, and "everywhere in between". Our stock is always in high demand and we always welcome additional goods for sale. We would be very appreciative of furniture etc donations from any of THA Members, at any time.

We would be happy to collect items from any THA Member in bulk lot, at no cost.

We have an efficient fleet of trucks and vans to transport donated goods, and a large warehouse in Moonah where goods are prepared for distribution to the shops. The shops include furniture houses currently in Argyle St Hobart , and Hopkins St Moonah.
