## **CHRISTMAS COMES EARLY WITH QANTAS OFFERING ADDITIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN MELBOURNE AND HOBART**

**SYDNEY, 22 December 2011:** Qantas Airways today announced it would significantly increase capacity between Melbourne and Hobart from 13 February to 23 March 2012.

The changes will see eighteen additional services added to the schedule - injecting 3024 seats to the market.

Details of the additional services include:

- Five additional flights from Melbourne to Hobart in February 2012
- Five additional flights from Hobart to Melbourne in February 2012
- Four additional flights from Melbourne to Hobart in March 2012
- Four additional flights from Hobart to Melbourne in March 2012

Qantas Regional General Manager Tasmania Stephen Farquer said, "Qantas is always focused on meeting increased market demands and responding with extra capacity, where possible.

"These additional services will provide our customers with seamless connections to and from the Qantas Group's international and domestic network out of Melbourne

"Hobart is a very important market for Qantas and we will continue to monitor demand to support tourism within the region," Mr Farquer said.
