



## HOBART LIQUOR ACCORD

The Hobart Liquor Accord is an initiative of liquor licensees in the greater Hobart area, the Liquor and Gaming Branch, the Tasmanian Hospitality Association, Tasmania Police, the Hobart City Council and the Hobart business community

### AIM

To encourage and promote best practice in licensed premises in Hobart and contribute to the safe well being of the local community by promoting responsible service of alcohol (RSA) and maintaining high standards of behaviour in and around licensed premises

### OBJECTIVES

- To promote Hobart as a safe and enjoyable location for residents and visitors
- To provide a forum on issues and practices that may impact on the community
- To build strong relationships between liquor licensees, government and community
- To assist in the reduction of alcohol related crime and anti-social behaviour
- To ensure compliance with the *Liquor Licensing Act 1990* and RSA practices
- To respect the rights and privileges of neighbours and residents
- The Government, as committed in the 2010 State Budget will investigate the legalities of the 'Pubwatch' program and advise the Tasmanian Hospitality Association (THA) of the outcomes of their investigations. If the investigations show that a 'Pubwatch' program is legal then the State Government will approve the purchase of the required system to allow the program to be undertaken

### ACCORD PRINCIPLES

The Hobart Liquor Accord is based on the following principles which the Accord members support and agree to:

- **Responsible service of alcohol**  
Adhere to the principles of responsible service of alcohol and actively promote safe and responsible consumption and serving practices
- **Improve safety and security**  
A commitment to improve the safety and security of patrons in and around licensed premises
- **Commitment of being good neighbours**  
Develop and maintain good relationships with persons living and working in the vicinity of licensed premises
- **Co-operate with Tasmania Police and the Liquor and Gaming Branch**  
Actively participate in accord initiatives and strategies and respond to the requests and advice of police and licensing authorities
